



Membership Criteria Policy

Bon Jour Social & Leisure Club is committed to providing a supportive and enriching environment for individuals with mild cognitive dementia. This criteria for membership ensures that all participants benefit from our social and leisure activities while receiving the appropriate level of care and support.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Cognitive Functioning:

Applicants and Members should demonstrate mild cognitive impairment without significant behavioral issues or advanced symptoms that would hinder participation in group activities. A preliminary assessment by a designated center staff member may be required.

2. Social Engagement:

Applicants and Members must be able to engage in social interactions and participate in group activities. While some support may be provided, the ability to engage with others in a structured environment is essential for maximizing the benefits of our programs.

3. Physical and Emotional Readiness:

Applicants should be physically and emotionally stable enough to participate in club activities. If needed, a medical clearance from a healthcare provider may be requested to ensure the applicant's safety and well-being during participation.

4. Support and Care:

Individuals requiring personal care or assistance beyond what is provided by the club must have a caregiver or support person who can accompany them. The caregiver must be responsible for providing any necessary personal assistance during club activities.

Application Process

1. Initial Inquiry:

Prospective members or their caregivers should contact the Bon Jour Social & Leisure Club to express interest and obtain an application form.

Complete the application form and submit the required documentation, including a formal diagnosis of mild cognitive dementia and any relevant medical clearances.

2. Assessment Meeting:

Schedule an assessment meeting with a club representative to discuss the applicant's needs, review documentation, and ensure that the club's programs align with the applicant's requirements.



3. Approval and Orientation:

Upon approval, new members will undergo an orientation to familiarize them with the club's facilities, programs, and support services.

4. Review and Adjustments:

Membership status will be periodically reviewed to ensure continued appropriateness. If changes in cognitive or physical health are noted, adjustments to the level of support or participation may be discussed and implemented as needed.
